# Saif Ali Khan accepts "Sacred Games" Netfilm offer

Mumbai, Nov 16: Actor Saif Ali Khan has revealed he is currently in the final stage of signing a Netflix film. Khan was one of the first mainstream Bollywood stars to enter the digital medium with Netflix's "Sacred Games" in 2018.

The new film, details of which are under wraps, would mark Khan's return to the streaming platform. "I recently heard a wonderful script for a Netflix movie. I absolutely loved the script, the idea and the director. We

are trying to sort out the dates before we lock. We are almost there," Khan told PTI. The 50-year-old actor has a packed line-up of releases ahead. He recently finished filming "Bunty Aur Babli 2" co-starring Rani Mukerji. Touted as a "rebooted sequel" to 2005 original, the film also features actors Siddhant Chaturvedi and Sharvati.

With "Bhoot Police" currently being shot with actors Arjun Kapoor, Jacqueline Fernandez and Yami Gautam the actor will delve in horror-comedy for the

first time. Khan would then feature as Lankesh in the multilingual period saga "Adipurush" - an on-screen adaptation of the Indian epic Ramayana. The film, also featuring "Baahubali" star Prabhas as Lord Ram, marks his second collaboration with director Om Raut after the hit "Tanhaji". On the digital space, Khan would feature in filmmaker Ali Abbas Zafar's "Tandav" as a politician. The Amazon Prime Video show is already set for a season two, Khan said.

# Lucky daughter birth makes Natarajan shave off beard

T Natarajan, a Tamil Nadu trundler was an unknown entity in cricket before recently concluded Indian Premier League (IPL) in the UAE. However, he hit the headlines with his toe-crushing yorkers in the tournament. It brought him into national reckoning. Natarajan was selected as a net bowler for the Indian team on its Down Under tour. However, the birth of his daughter coincided

with his call in the Indian squad for the tour of Australia. The lady luck smiled on Natarajan when spinner Varun Chakravarthy who had received his maiden national call-up for India's T20I series was ruled out because of a shoulder injury. It was heavenly sent opportunity for the pacer Natarajan. However, he will be away from home till the end of the Australian tour. His home-coming will only be possible in the third week of January. Consequently the newest member of the T20I Indian team will only be able to see his newly-born daughter after three months. Natarajan and his wife Pavithra were blessed with a baby girl last week when the 29-year-old medium

pacer was playing for Sunrisers Hyderabad in the Indian Premier League (IPL). "My daughter's birth has proven very lucky for me. I was selected only as a net bowler but am drafted in the main squad now. There can't be better news than this," he said over the telephone from his Dubai hotel room, where he went from IPL bubble to the BCCI bubble. "I am yet to have a photograph of my daughter. Could only see her on the video call. My wife is still in the hospital and is scheduled to return home in a day or two." "Natarajan has grown his beard and had vowed to shave it off only after the birth of the child. He was to visit the temple before that." Nevertheless,

he offered prayers in Dubai and shaved off his beard before leaving for Australia. N Sankar, Chairman, Sanmar group - has been running Chemplast cricket teams for more than five decades passionately is euphoric over Natarajan's selection in the Indian squad. He said, "Player development being the key mantra has resulted in more than 35 Test cricketers playing for India and 125 First class cricketers being employed during this time." Bharath Reddy (former Indian stumper) who manages the Chemplast cricket team pointed out that even in these difficult times, management had ensured that the cricketers were paid full salaries.
