



Ramco Cements gets Green Champion Award

Chennai, June 7: Government of Tamil Nadu has been encouraging people to proactively contribute to the field of environmental protection through its "Green Awards".

Every year this award is given to the District Collectors, Industries, Educational Institutions, and resident welfare associations.

In order to encourage the civil society toward environmental protection, the Tamil Nadu Government and Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board has included individuals as well for the award.

Hence from 2021-22, the award has been renamed as "Tamil Nadu Green Champion Award". The award includes prize money of Rs. 1 Lakh for each winning individual/organization and is given to 100 individuals/organizations for their exemplary contribution toward environment protection.

The focus areas for TN Green Champion Award are environmental education, training, awareness, protection, research and scientific studies for a new innovative Green product, sustainable development, solid waste management,

water conservation, and water bodies protection, climate change adaptation & mitigation, emission reduction, control & recycling of plastic waste, eco-restoration, conservation measure, and coastal area protection, etc.

Ramco Cements was invited by the District Collector to make a presentation along with other applicants. The committee after evaluating all the presentations selected Ramco Cements for the Green Champion Award. The award ceremony was held on the 6th June 2022 in connection with

the World Environment Day Celebration at Ariyalur Collectorate. The District Collector P. Ramana Saraswathi, IAS gave away the award with a cash prize of Rs. 1 Lakh.

The award was received by Mr. Madhusudan Kulkarni, Unit Head, Mr. S. Ramaraj - SVP (Admin), and Mr. L. Bobby Pravin - AGM (Mgmt. Services) on behalf of Ramco Cements. Dr. M. Senthil Kumar District Environmental Engineer TNPCB was also present on the occasion.

TAPMA's exhibition to give a fillip to TN plastics processing industry

Chennai, June 7: The Tamil Nadu Plastics Manufacturers' Association (TAPMA), a premier industry body of plastics processing industries in the state, is organizing an international plastics exhibition, IPLAS 2022, at Chennai Trade Center, between June 10-13, 2022, for the promotion of the industry, and the safe mechanisms for recycling of used plastic materials.

Spread over 13000 sqm, this four-day exhibition is expected to attract about 350 exhibitors and over 75,000 visitors. There will be live demos of machines from over 60 companies. IPLAS 2022 is expected to generate business worth about Rs. 500 crore for the exhibitors. Entry to the exhibition is FREE both to the business visitors and the general public.

S. Rakkappan, President, TAPMA, said that IPLAS is expected to give a fillip to Tamil Nadu's Rs. 15,000 crore plastic industry comprising 8000 plus factories. They provide direct and indirect employment to 3,00,000 and 5,00,000 people respectively. It contributes Rs. 2,700 crore to the GST annually. The sector is dominated by small scale units that account for nearly 85% of the registered units, while micro and medium units account for 5% each. Only 5% of the processors are large companies.

At present, the plastic industry in Tamil Nadu is growing only at 4-5% per annum. TAPMA has plans to submit a detailed white paper to the government for the promotion of the industry.

B. Swaminathan, Chairman - Environment Committee, TAPMA, added that TAPMA is committed to promoting compact safe recyclers.



It has plans to place the recyclers at public locations to demonstrate how dry waste is converted into granules that are used subsequently for production of different products. "We will be working with various corporations and

municipalities to install these recyclers for better plastic waste management and recycling. These compact safe recyclers will work on single phase power supply and will help rag pickers and other NGOs to see higher value addition in their efforts.

These technologies will ensure higher recovery of plastics waste from the municipal garbage. In a span of a few years, we expect the presence of plastics in the garbage to drop from 7% to 2%," he pointed out.

The voting rights of members shall be in proportion to their shareholding in the Company as on the beginning of the cut-off date.
