Close all illegal alcohol serving bars: Edappadi

Coimbatore, June 10: AIADMK general secretary Edappadi K Palaniswami on Tuesday urged the government to take steps to stop deaths allegedly happening after drinking at Tasmac bars and illegal facilities across the state. In a release, Palaniswami condemned the state for its "failure to curb illegal bars" and sought strict action against those involved in such business. Drawing attention to a recent incident in Kidaripatti near Melur where a man died allegedly after consuming alcohol from a Tasmac shop, Palaniswami criticised the government. He also said that two fish vendors had died in

Thanjavur district earlier in May allegedly after consuming alcohol from a Tasmac bar. Palaniswami also referred to news reports on another man from Madurai district dying under similar circumstances and two others getting hospitalised in critical condition. Palaniswami expressed scepticism over the police department's initial statement which came out even before a postmortem was completed saying the deceased had consumed thinner. He demanded excise department conduct raids on Tasmac shops and ensure compliance with regulations, checking for excise stickers on every bottle.

EPS slams DMK over electricity tariff hike for industries

Chennai, June 10: AIADMK general secretary Edappadi K Palaniswami has condemned the DMK government's move to increase power tariff for commercial establishments. In a statement on Friday, Palaniswami said it was proposed that Tangedco would get a revenue of 15,000 crore in 2021-2022 after increase in the power tariff. But due to bad administration, there is an artificial power shortage in the state. As a result, power is being purchased from exchanges at exorbitant rates, resulting in heavy loss to Tangedco, he charged. He said Tangedco should not be treated as a

commercial establishment, bent on making profits. It is meant for serving the people, he said. Hut dwellers, middle class people and commercial establishments should not be taxed heavily by the power utility, he said. The AIADMK did not hike power tariff for eight years. The government should bear the burden of loss incurred by Tangedco, he said. Former AIADMK coordinator O Panneerselvam in a statement, urged chief minister M K Stalin not to burden commercial establishments with a hike in power tariff. V K Sasikala tweeted calling the proposed tariff hike unfortunate.

All women Haj flight from God's Own Country

Perhaps for the first time in the Haj history, an all women Haj flight took off from Kozhikode International Airport at Karipur on Thursday. The sending off witnessed Union Minister of State for Minority Affairs John Barla flagging off the special flight and distribution of boarding passes for the first flight. God's Own Country takes the credit of organising the all women haj flight with the pilot and crew of the aircraft being women. Sources said that the Air India Express flight left Karipur at 6.45 pm carrying 145 women hajjas with six women crew marking the first such flight from Kerala. This is the first time the women pilgrims are performing the hajj without mahram or a male companion. Barla said that the women-only flight marked a glorious step for women's empowerment in the country and requested the pilgrims to pray for the country's safety and security as well as progress. Notably, the women crew performed the dispatch, flight operation, loading, cleaning, engineering, ground service and other

related activities at all levels thereby making the pilgrimage trip different. The Minister as a token of inaugurating the special all women haj flight gave away a boarding pass to 76-year-old Sulaikha, the senior most member of the team. The minister expressed happiness over the arrangements being made for the pilgrims by the State Haj Committee. Eleven flights have been scheduled till Monday only for women pilgrims leaving via Karipur airport. 1,595 women pilgrims belonging to the 'ladies without mahram' category will depart on several days in eleven flights. The rest will travel on other flights. About 2,733 people are leaving this year from the state through the 'ladies without mahram' category. Out of this, 1718 people will depart via Karipur, 563 via Kochi and 452 via Kannur embarkation points. Interestingly, the oldest woman pilgrim, Khadiumma (87), a native of Nediyruppu in Malappuram district, departed at 4.20 am flight today. Moreover, about 69 men and 76 women took off from Karipur at 9am flight IX 3021

on Thursday. The second flight from Kochi left at 11.30 on Friday. In Andhra Pradesh, Chief Minister Jagan Mohan Reddy who met the batch of Muslims leaving for Mecca at the Haj House here on Thursday said that the Government has appointed a Hajj Committee which is accompanying the pilgrims to ensure hassle-free journey. This is the first time that pilgrims are leaving for Hajj from Vijayawada embarkation point. "Deputy Chief Minister Amjad Basha, who is accompanying you, will take care of you and will inform me in case of any need," the CM said, wishing pilgrims all the best. It may be noted that every year, millions of Muslims across the globe embark on a sacred pilgrimage known as Hajj. This spiritual journey holds immense significance in the lives of believers, offering an opportunity to connect with Allah, seek forgiveness, and strengthen their faith. The heartfelt desire to be among those walking to Mina, echoing the Labaik with the crowd, and performing the rituals of Hajj is a sentiment shared by countless individuals.
